# **Project Title**

# Accomplishments over the past Month:

- Surveyed manholes on trunkline sewer from Dettman Road Sewer collapse downstream to Main Lift Station
- Completed manhole assessments on trunkline sewer from Dettman Road Sewer collapse downstream to Main Lift Station
  - Completed preliminary review of manhole assessment data
- Received Bids for trunkline Sewer CCTV, Subcontracting with Clean Earth Environmental Services for \$42,960.60.

# Anticipated Accomplishments this next Month (June):

- > F&V will complete survey on manholes for the remainder of the collection system
- > F&V will start manhole assessments for the remainder of the collection system
- > F&V will create a draft GIS basemap, and update manhole naming convention
- > F&V will coordinate the start of cleaning and televising of the trunkline sewer with Clean Earth Environmental Services.
- > Township will discuss the purchase of a vactor truck (June XX Meeting)

### Anticipated Accomplishments in the near future (next few Months):

- > F&V will complete survey and manhole inspections
- > Cleaning and CCTV of the trunkline sewer will be completed, along with a preliminary analysis of the condition of the sewer
- > F&V will create a specification package for cleaning and CCTV of the remainder of the collection system

- > Possible reimbursement of Force Main Study (~\$23,000).
- > Cost savings for combining survey projects with the SAW Survey
